CHORLEY BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2019

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle or cycle to proceed over that length of New Road, Coppull from Spendmore Lane to Lower Burgh Way in the Chorley Borough.
2. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0930 hours until 1500 hours on Tuesday 19th March 2019 and Wednesday 20th March 2019 or until completion of the works within this period. Access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. School buses will be accommodated during this closure.
3. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Yarrow Valley Way – Foxhole Road – Southport Road – Balshaw Lane – Wigan Road – Preston Road – Spendmore Lane.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow carriageway surface dressing patching works to be carried out.
