(SPENDMORE LANE, COPPULL, CHORLEY BOROUGH)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2019

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Spendmore Lane, Coppull from point of the railway bridge travelling in either direction for approximately 20 metres.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative nightly between 2200 hours until 0530 hours on Thursday 30<sup>th</sup> January 2020 until Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> February 2020 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Spendmore Lane - Chapel Lane – Coppull Moor Lane – A49 Preston Road - Spendmore Lane

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Network Rail to carry out bridge strike sign works.
