(CHURCH LANE, CHARNOCK RICHARD, CHORLEY BOROUGH)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2020

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council intend to make an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Church Lane, Charnock Richard at point of the railway bridge travelling in either direction for approximately 20 metres.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative over 5 consecutive weekends as follows:-

From 2330 hours on Saturday 17th October 2020 until 0900 hours on Sunday 18th October 2020

From 2330 hours on Saturday 24th October 2020 until 0900 hours on Sunday 25th October 2020

From 2330 hours on Saturday 31st October 2020 until 0900 hours on Sunday 1st November 2020

From 2330 hours on Saturday 7th November 2020 until 0900 hours on Sunday 8th November 2020

From 2330 hours on Saturday 14th November 2020 until 0900 hours on Sunday 15th November 2020

4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Church Lane – Chorley Lane – Charter Lane

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Network Rail bridge repair works to be carried out.
