(SPENDMORE LANE, COPPULL, CHORLEY BOROUGH)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2020

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle or cycle to proceed over that length of Spendmore Lane, Coppull travelling in either direction of the bridge for approximately 20 meters.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 2200 hours on Friday 9th October 2020 until 0500 hours on Saturday 10th October 2020 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Spendmore Lane – Preston Road – Coppull Moor Lane – Lancaster Street – Spendmore Lane

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Network Rail to carry out the installation of bridge height warning sign.
