(CHURCH LANE, CHARNOCK RICHARD, CHORLEY BOROUGH)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2020

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council intend to make an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Church Lane, Charnock Richard at point of the railway bridge travelling in either direction for approximately 20 metres.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 2330 hours until 0900 on the following dates:-
  - Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> January 2021 to Sunday 31<sup>st</sup> January 2021
  - Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> February 2021 to Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> February 2021
  - Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> February 2021 to Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> February 2021

4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Church Lane – Chorley Lane – Charter Lane

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Network Rail to carry out bridge repair works.
